According to Malaysian Qualification Agency (MQA) Micro-credential is defined as digital certification of assessed knowledge, skills and competencies in a specific area or field which can be a component of an accredited programme or stand-alone courses supporting the professional, technical, academic and personal development of the learners.

CREDIT TRANSFER

ACCREDITATION OF PRIOR EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING (APEL)

The MQF recognises the importance and value of nonformal and informal learning in higher education. MQA has developed the APEL (C) guidelines which permit nonformal and informal learning to be evaluated and accorded recognition or credit by recognised APEL (C) centres.

APEL C

Assessment of accumulated knowledge (informal and non-formal) acquired through life experiences that are relevant for the purpose of credit award or courses exemption. ➤

Maximum credit transfer allowed: 30% from total credit hours needed to graduate
