

1.5 Abstract

An abstract is a brief, comprehensive summary of the contents of the paper. Abstract typically are limited to not more than 250 words. The words "Abstract" in your paper must be centered at the top of the page and in bold title case. Abstract is written in a single paragraph without indentation and labels are inserted to identify various sections (eg: objective, method, result, conclusions)

2. In-text citation: Author/s

In-text citation is a works credited in the text to avoid plagiarism, furthermore to briefly identify the source of information in the body text.

There are have two formats of in-text citation:

Parenthetical citation	(Moosa, 2022)	The author name and publication date

Parenthetical citation:

Both the author and the date, separated by a comma, appears in parentheses for a parenthetical citation. A parenthetical citation can appear within or at the end of the sentence. As for the example:

Narrative citation:

The author appears in running text and the date appears in parentheses immediately after the author name for a narrative citation. As for the example:
