## 1. Purpose And Scope

- 1.1. This document outlines the responsibilities, processes, and resources for developing and offering online services at Management and Science University and its collaborative associates.

## 3. Policy Statement

### 3.1. Principles.

The strategic vision of MSU's Online Education is to provide high-quality and affordable educational experience that has impact on students and the community in transforming and enriching the lives of the students.

### 3.2. Academic And Student Services

Students regardless of their race, gender, religion, disability, age enrolled in online education courses/programmes have access to services comparable to those provided for students in conventional programmes, including, but not limited to academic support (e.g., academic advising, accessibility services, library), administrative support (e.g., registrar, student financial services office, financial aid, bookstore), student services support (e.g., counseling, career services, international student services), and technical support. Students in online education courses/programmes have access to procedures for resolving complaints, as noted in the Student Handbook.

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
