SMOKE-FREE CAMPUS POLICY			

1. PURPOSE

1.1. To provide guidelines for staff and students on no smoking rules within MSU campus and properties

2. APPLICABILITY

All MSU staffs and students

3. .POLICY STATEMENT

3.1. Principles

3.1.1. It is the policy of MSU to provide a smoke free environment for its students, faculty, staff, administrators, visitors and the general public attending campus events.

3.2. Provisions

MSU’s prohibition on smoking encompasses the following:

3.2.1. The University shall be a smoke-free campus. Smoking is prohibited on university owned or leased property, except for officially posted designated smoking areas. The sale of tobacco products on campus is prohibited.

3.2.2. Smoking shall be prohibited in any campus-owned building or leased space. This prohibition shall apply to any area enclosed by the outermost walls of the building. Atriums, balconies, stairwells, and other similar building features are to be considered "within a building."

3.2.3. Smoking is prohibited at all times in any University owned vehicle. The smoking prohibition applies to passenger vehicles and all other state-owned mobile equipment to include light and heavy trucks, cargo and passenger vans, buses, and any other mobile equipment with an enclosed or enclosable driver/passenger compartment.
